Jason Page Sworn In as New Board of Education Director

Jason Page was sworn in to serve on the Douglas County School District (DCSD) Board of Education on June 27, 2023. He is assuming the role of Director for District C, which includes portions of Highlands Ranch. Page was recently named following a series of interviews with finalists selected by the DCSD Board of Education.

Page is a parent of a DCSD student and has advanced degrees in both leadership and business administration (with a concentration in strategic leadership). He has led international teams in multiple organizations, including entertainment, government, education, global resources, and global consulting.

“In my current career as an IT professional, I have led both local and international teams in many different arenas, including local government, mining, education, oil and gas, data centers, and global consulting. I have gained specialized training in process development, organizational change management, problem solving and decision-making analysis, customer support, and product management,” said Page. “These skills have provided me the ability to bring together disparate voices and drive to consensus, even when there are still disagreements between parties.”

Page has most recently served two years on the board of directors at Ben Franklin Academy (2020-2022), a public charter school in Highlands Ranch, and concurrently represented charter schools on the DCSD long range planning committee. He holds a Bachelor’s degree in Music Education and spent time as a music teacher and band director.

Page’s term will expire November 2023.
