

St. Clair County Summer School 2024



June 3- July 25

All classes will be taught in a blended in-person/virtual format and require 7 face-to-face meetings each Monday during the 7-week term.

Registration

- Registration Dates: **May 1- May 31, 2024**
- Each course is \$150 with a maximum of two courses taken during summer term.

- **All summer school fees must be paid at time of registration.**

General Information

- Summer School Dates: June 3, 2024-July 25, 2024 (7-week Summer Term)
- Summer School Grades: 5th thru 12th grade (limited to two courses)
- All courses will be delivered virtually using the Imagine Learning Edgenuity Platform. SCC instructors will communicate with students using MS TEAMS for student conferences and tutoring. (limited to two courses)
- Summer School Orientation will be conducted by a Summer School instructor via MS Teams after the student has registered and been enrolled in his/her course/s. All classes and work must be completed by July 25th.
- Cost: \$150 for one course. Each course cost is \$250 for any student out of the St. Clair County School zone.
- Students must complete their work within the summer school session dates. There will be no extensions given to complete course requirements and no refunds given after the start of the summer school term.
- Weekly attendance is required. If a student misses more than one Monday in-person session, the student will be withdrawn from the course, given a grade of "F," and reported to local school.
- The St. Clair County Code of Student Conduct will be strictly enforced. Any student referred for discipline reasons will be suspended from the summer term, receive a grade of "F," and will not receive a refund.

Courses (.5 or 1 Credit) \$150.00

- **Credit Recovery (CR)** Courses may include any courses from the Edgenuity Alabama course catalog, refer to attachment for comprehensive list. If a needed course is not listed, contact Jill Tidmore at (205)640-8710 or 594-7492.
- Unless specified on registration form, students will be enrolled in a full-year course. Please ensure that all course codes and titles requested reflects the correct course information, i.e., FY, CR, or Course A or B, etc. The entire Edgenuity catalog of courses are available for enrollment.
- Two full-course max or a combination of courses equating to a total of 2.0 credits will be permitted.

Dates & Times:

- Week 1 (June 3rd – June 5th): Monday – Wednesday; 8:00am – 1:00pm
- Week 2 (June 10th – June 12th): Monday – Wednesday; 8:00am – 1:00pm
- Weeks 3-7 (June 17th – July 25th) Monday-Thursday; Follow Driving Group Schedule

Requirements:

- Each student must bring a copy of their permit on the first day of class.
- Each student is required 30 seat hours of face-to-face class time.
- Also, students need to make sure they have logged a minimum of 50 practice hours behind the wheel with a parent/guardian by the end of the second week (you may also backdate this log with any substantial driving time that you have already performed)
- Notebook, pencil/pen, and a device.

Course Outline:

- Weeks 1 & 2 Classroom time (in-person), as we are required to have 30 hours of classroom instruction before getting behind the wheel. The Boater certification test will also be administered during this time.
- Weeks 3-7 will be our driving time. You will be broken up into driving groups and assigned a location and time for your group to drive.
(NO STUDENT WILL BE ALLOWED TO HANGOUT ON CAMPUS WHILE WAITING TO DRIVE, SO PLEASE MAKE ARRANGEMENTS TO SHOW UP AT YOUR ASSIGNED TIME)
- Road test examinations will be scheduled based on student driver's capability and readiness. If student drivers meet qualifications to test, this will be incorporated during the assigned group driving time.

Driver Education Health
