The Bedford Central School District serves the towns of Bedford, Mount Kisco, Pound Ridge, and parts of New Castle and North Castle. The District is comprised of one high school, one middle school and five elementary schools located throughout the community, in addition to an alternate high school program.

Our mission is to cultivate curiosity and a passion for learning by providing challenging educational opportunities for all students so they may achieve their full potential as productive and contributing members of society.

The Board of Education meets on Wednesday evenings, approximately twice monthly except during March, when they meet more often to discuss and finalize the following school year's budget; the schedule of Board meetings is posted on our website. The Board of Education meetings are streamed live on the website and broadcast live on BCSD TV (FIOS Channel 1982 and Cablevision Channel 18).

The Board of Education encourages and engages in open communication with the members of the community on all aspects of District operations. Partnering with our community members is a high priority for the Board of Education and Administration.

The Board has established the following community advisory committees that meets throughout the school year:

- Space and Enrollment Advisory
