

PERMISSION TO DRIVE AND UTILIZE PARKING

_____ has my permission to drive a motor vehicle to Jasper High School during this school year 2023-2024. School administration has the authority to examine the contents of any motor vehicle located on school property when there is reason to believe that the contents of the vehicle may include elements which: (a) present an immediate threat to the health, safety, or welfare of the student body; (b) are illegal to possess; (c) would contribute to the disruption of the normal educational program; and/or (d) have been reported lost or stolen. A law enforcement agency may, at the request of the school administration, assist in searching a vehicle and its contents.

DRIVING AND PARKING INFORMATION

During the 2023-2024 school year, we will provide police supervision of student drivers during the morning and afternoon. This program has greatly reduced the number of traffic accidents and problems. Students will purchase yearly parking permits at the cost of **\$25.00 to be paid in full**. Students who will be purchasing a parking permit **second semester** can purchase one for **\$15.00**. Students who drive more than one vehicle to school may purchase an additional permit for **\$5.00** per car.

Students and parents are reminded that the police are not parking attendants and that the responsibility for orderly parking is the responsibility of the students. The blocking of exits and blocking in of other students is not permitted. Please remember that driving to school is a privilege that may be taken away.
