Economic Landscape

Headwinds

- For the second consecutive year, inflation significantly outpaces allowable budget growth
- Health Insurance costs expected to rise 13.0%
- Pension costs (ERS and TRS) estimated to increase
- Cash reserves contribution will be necessary to comply with the tax cap limits

Economic Landscape

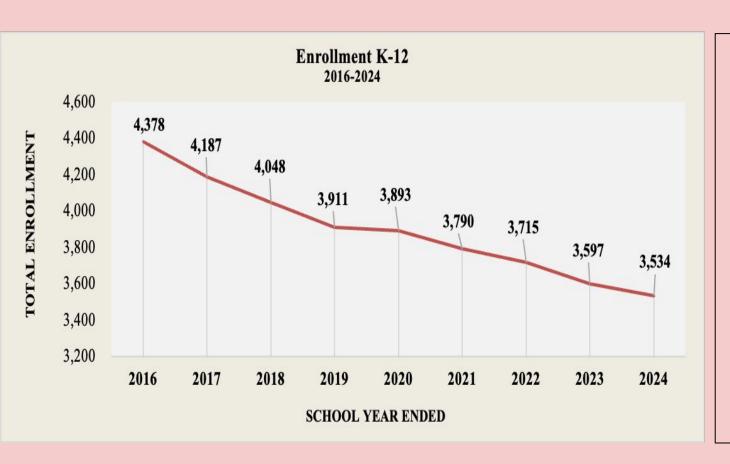
Tailwinds

- Revenue on deposit accounts will increase due to rising interest rates
- County sales tax revenue estimate will increase
- Increased internal controls have resulted in cost containment in key areas of focus
- Expect to reduce cash reserve contribution

Items of Impact

- BTA contract negotiations are ongoing
- Disposition of seven (7.0) remaining covid-funded positions
 - 4.0 Elementary teachers, 2.0 Library Media Specialists, 1.0 ESOL
 (FLHS)
- Discussions regarding health insurance (consortium vs. self insured) are ongoing
- How to address low student enrollment K-5?
- What are our options to deal with chronic cash reserve support of budget?

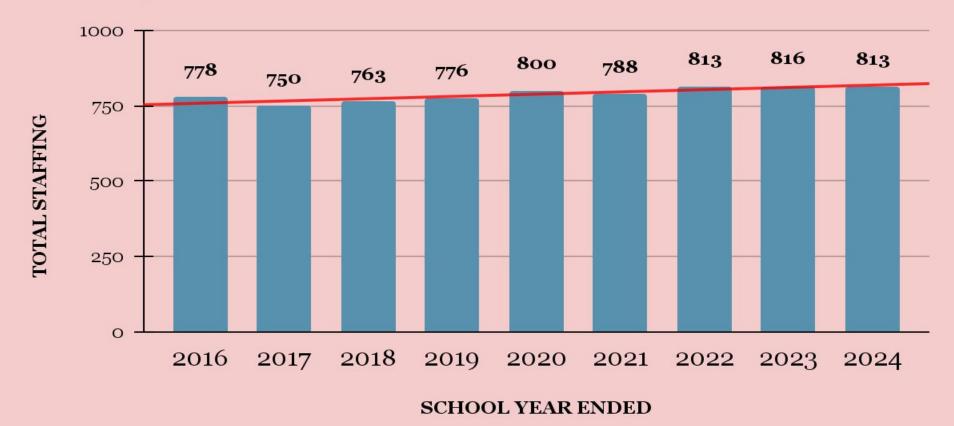
Enrollment
