Administration

Educational Research

All requests to conduct research within The Academy must be approved by the Head of School or his/her designee. Requests must be made formally, align to the criteria outlined below and must follow national and international standards related to educational research. The following criteria will be utilized to make a determination regarding approval of such requests:

- 1. The study results in direct benefits or provides direct services to the children of The Woodstock Academy;
- 2. The study provides in-service opportunities for the growth and development of faculty and/or staff;
- 3. There be no expenditures of Academy funds or use of staff/faculty time unless there are benefits as described in 1 and 2 above; and
- 4. Students participating in studies, authorized by school administration, must have the approval of their parents.

All research results should be shared with the Head of School or his/her designee.
