Directions: Bullying, harassment, and intimidation are serious and will not be tolerated. This is a form to report alleged harassment and intimidation (bullying) that occurred on school property; at a school-sponsored activity or event off school property; on a school bus; or on the way to and/or from school, in the current school year. If you are a student victim, the parent/guardian of a student victim, a close adult relative of a student victim, or a school staff member and wish to report an incident of alleged bullying, harassment or intimidation, complete this form and return it to the Dean of Students at The Woodstock Academy. Contact the school for additional information or assistance at any time.

Public Act 11-232, Section 1. Section 10-222d (July 1, 2011)

- 1) "Bullying" means (A) the repeated use by one or more students of a written, oral or electronic communication, such as cyberbullying, directed at or referring to another student attending school in the same school district, or (B) a physical act or gesture by one or more students repeatedly directed at another student attending school in the same school district, that:
- (i) Causes physical or emotional harm to such student, or damage to such student's property,
- (ii) places such student in reasonable fear of harm to himself or herself, or of damage to his or her property,
- (iii) creates a hostile environment at school for such student,
- (iv) infringes on the rights of such student at school, or
- (v) substantially disrupts the education process or the orderly operation of a school. Bullying shall include, but not be limited to, a written, oral, or electronic communication or physical act or gesture based on any actual or perceived differentiating characteristic, such as race, color, religion, ancestry, national origin, gender, sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, socioeconomic status, academic status, physical appearance, or mental, physical, developmental or sensory disability, or by association with an individual or group who has, or is perceived to have one or more of such characteristics;
- 2) "Cyberbullying" means any act of bullying through the use of the Internet, interactive and digital technologies, cellular mobile telephone or other mobile electronic devices, or any electronic communications.
