

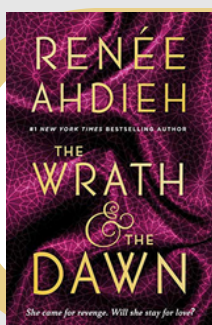
# SUMMER READING

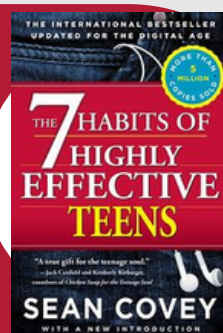


## THE WRATH AND THE DAWN - RENEE ANDIEH

a retelling of Arabian Nights - A girl marries an evil prince in order to get revenge on him for her friend's death, but she finds herself torn as she learns there is more at play than outward appearances.

a popular self-help book aimed at teaching teenagers seven habits to improve their lives and make them happier, more productive, and more self-confident



## LEGEND - MARIE LU

In a dystopian Republic, a teen on the streets fights to survive. A young girl, a prodigy, is determined to find him and make him pay for his crimes. Together, however, they discover that the Republic is keeping secrets, and they will have to reconsider everything they thought was true.

## FALLEN ANGELS - WALTER DEAN MYERS

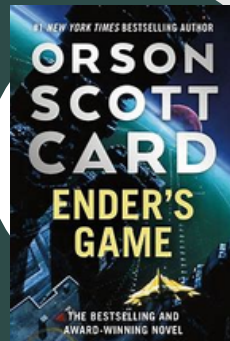


## STRANGE, UNEARTHLY THINGS - KELLY CREASH
