Board of Education

The Board of Education meets two times each month with the exception of July, November and December when only one meeting is held. The Board of Education meets annually for Board Self Evaluation. The Committee of the Whole (COW) Meeting is held the second Thursday of each month. The Regular Action Meeting (RAM) is held the fourth Thursday of each month. The following exceptions are noted:

- July 11 2024 Regular Action Meeting (second Thursday)
- October 9 2024 Committee of the Whole (Wednesday)
- November 21 2024 Regular Action Meeting (third Thursday)
- December 12 2024 Regular Action Meeting (second Thursday)
- February 26 2025 Regular Action Meeting (Wednesday)

Meetings will be held at 6:00 pm.

In odd months (January, March, May, July, September and November) board meetings will be held at Hinsdale Central. In even months (February, April, June, August, October and December) board meetings will be held at Hinsdale South.

Public notice of each meeting will be posted in [BoardDocs - https://www.boarddocs.com/il/hinsdale86/Board.nsf](https://www.boarddocs.com/il/hinsdale86/Board.nsf) no later than 48 hours prior to the meeting including the date, time, location and meeting agenda.

Meeting dates and start times may vary from the regular schedule. These changes will be posted according to OMA requirements.

Board of Education Committees - To Be Announced

Board of Education committees will plan to meet on a regular schedule. The committees will announce changes to their anticipated meeting dates pursuant to Section 2.02 of the Illinois Open Meetings Act. Public notice of each committee meeting will be posted on the District's website, at the principal office and at the meeting location prior to each meeting including the date, time, location and meeting agenda. Committee meetings will be canceled when a meeting is not needed.

Parent-Teacher Advisory Committee:

Per Policy 2:150 the PTAC annually reviews pupil discipline policies, the implementation of those policies, and any other factors related to the safety of the schools, pupils and staff.

Closed Session Minutes Review Committee:

Per Policy 2:200 the Closed Session Minutes Review Committee meets every six months (November and May), or as soon after as is practicable, to review minutes from all closed meetings to determine if there are meeting minutes that no longer require confidential treatment and may be released to the public.
