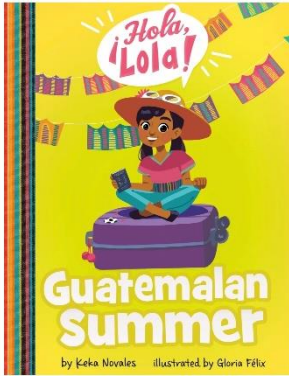

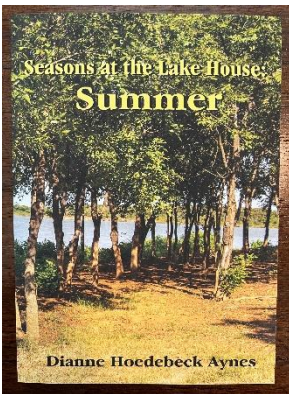

**(for ages 5 to 8 years)**

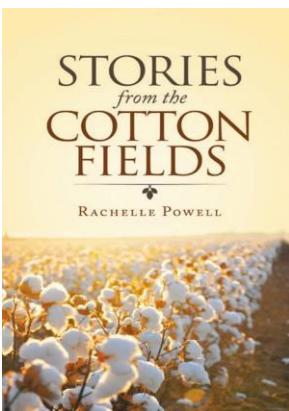
In this charming book, Lola, accompanied by her grandmother (*Abuelita*), embarks on an adventure to explore her heritage, and connect with her relatives.
