PLEASE NOTE: All prescribed medication for the 2024-25 school year requires a completed **Doctor's Order** and a parent/guardian must bring the medication to the Health Office. **All medication and completed forms must be dropped off no later than August 20.** Your child will NOT be able to start school without their medication and a Doctor's Order on file. ATTENTION: Current Pre-K Families Attending Kindergarten in 2024-25

This is a reminder that the California Department of Public Health and Orange County Department of Education mandates that your child meet the immunization requirement in order to attend Kindergarten. If your student is currently enrolled in ECD, we still **need a copy of the records submitted to our office no later than August 2, 2024**. Please submit a current copy of one of the following documents to the Health Office via fax or **email**:

- A copy of your child's yellow California Immunization Card OR
- A copy of the immunization record from your doctor's office

If you have already submitted this documentation, thank you! Pediatricians' offices tend to be extremely busy during the summer months. Please allow yourself ample time to get these mandatory documents to the Health Office. The nurse will review your child's records and you will be notified of any missing shots needed to fulfill the state requirements. California law requires that all immunizations be up to date in order for a child to attend the first day of Kindergarten. There are NO exceptions to this rule.

Kindergarten: Oral Health Assessment Form is Due TOMORROW, May 31

California law requires that students enrolled in kindergarten receive an oral health assessment by a licensed dental health professional, and submit a completed <u>Oral Health</u> <u>Assessment Form</u> to the child's school. Oral health assessments must occur between 12 months prior to the start of Kindergarten and the end of the Kindergarten year on May 31. To fulfill the requirement, please complete and submit this <u>Oral Health Assessment</u> <u>Form</u>, as follows. Parent/guardian must complete:

- Section #1. Licensed dental professional must fill out and sign or stamp
- Section #2. Parent/guardian must return the completed form to the St. John's Health Office by Friday, May 31. To claim an exemption from this requirement, parent/guardian must complete Section #3 and return to the Health Office by Friday, May 31.

ATTENTION: Incoming 7th Grade Families

This is a reminder that the California Department of Public Health and Orange County Department of Education mandates that your child meet the immunization requirement in order to attend 7th Grade in the 2024-25 school year. All documents listed below must be received no later than August 2, 2024. California law requires that all immunizations be up to date in order for a child to attend the first day of 7th grade. There are NO exceptions to this rule. There is NO GRACE PERIOD.

Please submit a current copy of one of the following documents to the Health Office via fax or **email**:

- Tdap Immunization, for (tetanus, diphtheria, and pertussis).
- Varicella #2 Immunization, for chicken pox.

Please note: many of your children have already been given a Tdap and/or have received their varicella #2; please check with your child's doctor.
