





Students meeting state grade-level expectations




#### **MATHEMATICS**

#### School Goals

AES strives to promote school success by focusing on academic support and enrichment as well as positive behavior interventions and supports. In the Title I program, we work with students at their level to build knowledge and skills in reading and math. Through our PBIS program, we work on building a positive school culture focused on safe, responsible, and respectful behavior. As a result of this work, we have seen students make progress in both reading and math and a decrease in the number of office referrals.

#### State Goals

The Oregon Department of Education is partnering with school districts and local communities to ensure a 90% ontime, four year graduation rate by 2027. To progress toward this goal, the state will prioritize efforts to improve attendance, provide a well-rounded education, invest in implementing culturally responsive practices, and promote continuous improvement to close opportunity and achievement gaps for historically and currently underserved students.




