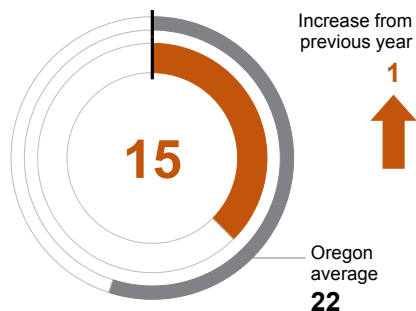

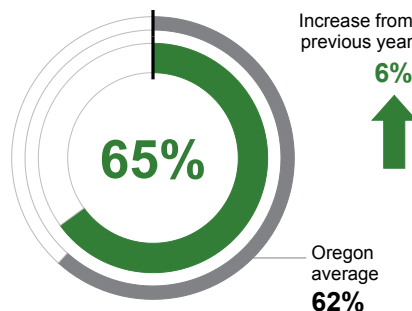
CLASS SIZE

REGULAR ATTENDERS

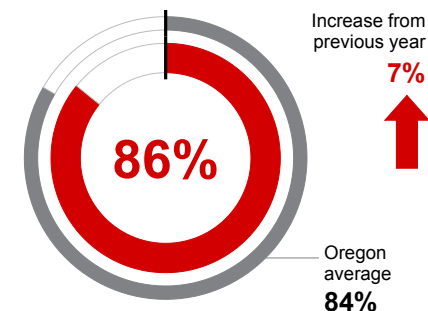

ON-TRACK TO GRADUATE

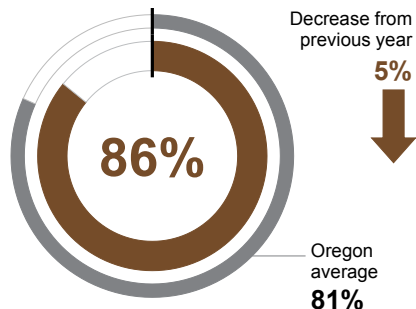
Students earning one-quarter of graduation credits in their 9th grade year.

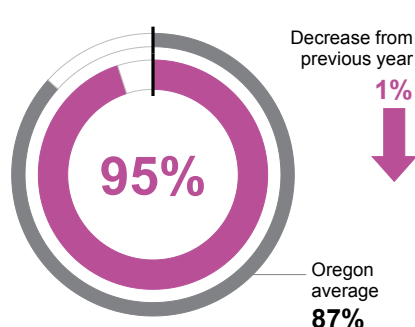
ON-TIME GRADUATION

Students earning a diploma within four years. Cohort includes students who were first-time ninth graders in 2018-19 graduating in 2021-22.



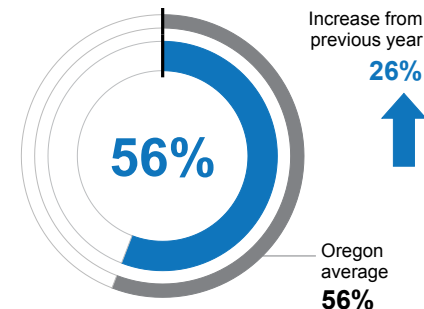
FIVE-YEAR COMPLETION

School Goals

Amity High School staff, students and families are continuing to work together to ensure any education gaps are being addressed. We do this by providing an atmosphere where students want to attend regularly, engage with learning and achieve to their highest potential. Staff have scheduled opportunities to work in grade level teams to evaluate every student's achievement, attendance, and behavior. Interventions are used to assist in meeting the needs of all students. The goal of this work is to increase the our grade 9 on track percentage, attendance percentage, graduation rate, and post high school success.

State Goals

The Oregon Department of Education is partnering with school districts and local communities to ensure a 90% on-time, four year graduation rate by 2027. To progress toward this goal, the state will prioritize efforts to improve attendance, provide a well-rounded education, invest in implementing culturally responsive practices, and promote continuous improvement to close opportunity and achievement gaps for historically and currently underserved students.

Safe & Welcoming Environment

Students deserve to feel safe, welcomed, and able to achieve. The addition of a student support coach has provided our students an opportunity to problem solve and connect with the school. We have increased our capacity to communicate with all families in their home language and provide interpreting services. We strive to make Amity High School accessible to all families. The atmosphere during the school day is quiet and organized. We encourage all students to get involved beyond the classroom.
