

Age:

Children must be age 5 on or before September 1st to be eligible for Kindergarten in Oregon

Our Kindergarten program is designed to provide young students with a playful, caring, cognitively challenging, and child and family centered start in school. All students will participate in:

- Age-appropriate learning that will include
 - daily learning
 - structured play
- Bi-weekly time with specialists (Music, Physical Education)
- Once a week time with Health and Wellness Specialists and Media Technician.

Kindergarten Readiness: The Basics

- > Follow 2 step directions
- Share and take turns
- ➤ Use the bathroom independently and then wash own hands
- Manage strong emotions
- Maneuver zippers, buttons, and shoelaces with limited support
- Take responsibility (example: If you spill something, clean it)



Kindergarten Readiness:

Playfully and Joyfully:

- Practice saying, recognizing, and writing your name
- Trace and name letters
- Count to 20 and recognizing numbers 0-10
- Name colors
- Read together and connect with books through shared life experiences
- Read/Sing nursery rhymes and tongue twisters
- Talk, Talk, Talk
