* 1. Please describe how your LEA identified the most important educational needs resulting from COVID-19?

The JCSD convened several meetings at the onset of school closures due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Weekly Administrative Team meetings have been held, which included the following personnel members: Superintendent, School Board president, Curriculum, SPED, CTE, CNP, Federal Programs/Student Services, Business, HR, Technology Directors, and all 13 school principals. Moreover, a smaller group meeting was completed after receiving knowledge of the distribution of CARES funds for local LEAs. Representatives from all three attendance centers, along with the JCSD Business manager, Assistant Business Manager, SPED Director, JCTC CTE Director, Curriculum Director, and Federal Programs Director met and discussed several needs to include the need to provide compensatory education for students with IEPs, a need to remediate all students' academic gaps, and technologies needed to ensure that students had access to academic content using a variety of methods. In later meetings, safety and health concerns were discussed and it was concluded that JCSD had a need for a certified registered nurse to benefit all three attendance centers.

* 2. Please share your LEA's proposed timeline for providing services and assistance to students and staff in both public and non-public schools.

Upon receiving the FY20 ESSER funds, JCSD will hire after school and day tutors, interventionists, and nurses. These personnel members will begin providing services at the start of the 2020-2021 school year for all students in all three attendance centers. Additionally, educational technology and intervention software and/or renewals will be encumbered as soon as the FY20 ESSER application is approved and funding is available in preparation for the beginning of school. During the first week of school, diagnostic assessments will be administered to all students in grades K-12, and intervention groups will be formed to meet the academic needs of all students. All interventions will be provided to all students throughout the 2020-21 school year. If carryover funding is carried over and available for personnel during the 2021-22 school year, intervention/remediation services and any other ESSER-funded activities will continue. Funding will also be utilized to ensure that CDC and/or MDE distancing guidelines are being met, such as the development of outdoor classrooms and other technologies that reach several students in a larger space.

* 3. Describe the extent to which your LEA intends to use ESSER funds to promote remote learning.

Currently, all teachers will engage in Summer training to develop curriculum for an online Learning Management System. Laptops will be purchased for teachers to utilize remotely to administer curriculum to students online. Moreover, student laptops will be purchased to ensure that all students have access to technology to increase learning. Teachers will also participate in professional development opportunities that increase overall teacher efficacy in technology usage and their ability to effectively use technology to deliver creative, meaningful instruction in an online learning environment. Technologies will also be purchased for to improve distance learning STEAM opportunities for students.

* 4. How will your LEA assess and address student learning gaps resulting from the disruption in educational services?

JCSD will assess each student at the beginning of the 2020-2021 school year using various diagnostic tools, and re-assess them during the 2021-2022 school year if carryover ESSER funds are available for usage. Once students are assessed and academic gaps revealed, local schools will form intervention groups and assign interventionists and/or tutors appropriately. Additionally, after school tutors will also be utilized to provide compensatory and remedial services.

* 5. Describe how your LEA will ensure that all eligible students, teachers, and other program beneficiaries have an equal opportunity to participate in any project or activity carried out under the ESSER program. (20 U.S.C. §1228(a)(1))

All students, teachers, and other program beneficiaries will have equal access to technology, nursing services, professional development opportunities to improve intervention and technology usage effectiveness, all remediation/intervention services and any other service/activity utilizing ESSER funding. All schools in the Jackson County School District will utilize ESSER funds for various services, personnel, or projects.

* 6. Describe how your LEA will promote the expectations of meeting high standards to students, teachers, and other beneficiaries. (20 U.S.C. §1228(a)(2))

All local school principals have developed academic intervention plans with an outlined monitoring explanation to ensure that rigor and relevance is maintained during all intervention/remediation services. Teachers will also continue to promote the overall academic development of all students using their online platforms to communicate with parents and students to address instructional deficits and meet the academic needs of students.

(6) that any application, evaluation, periodic program plan or report relating to each program will be made readily available to parents and other members of the general public;

(7) that in the case of any project involving construction -

(8) that the local educational agency has adopted effective procedures for acquiring and disseminating to teachers and administrators participating in each program significant information from educational research, demonstrations, and similar projects, and for adopting, where appropriate, promising educational practices developed through such projects; and

(9) that none of the funds expended under any applicable program will be used to acquire equipment (including computer software) in any instance in which such acquisition results in a direct financial benefit to any organization representing the interests of the purchasing entity or its employees or any affiliate of such an organization.

10. This application remains in effect for the duration of the program. The LEA will submit a revision to the application if any budget changes are required in accordance with the MDE revision process.
