Tonight, Superintendent Highsmith will present the deficit mitigation plans for the 2024-2025 School Year. The Hamden Board of Education proposed budget was not fully funded by the Hamden Legislative Council. As a result, Superintendent Highsmith and the Hamden Board of Education must reduce the district's overall budget by 3.1 million. Parents and family members can attend the meeting in person or virtually to gain a greater understanding of the budgetary impact on Hamden Middle School. # PARKING

Guests will be able to park their vehicles on the side lot. We recommend families to drive together to the celebration to reduce the number of vehicles. Listen to the directions of our staff; they are ready to help!

#### DISMISSAL

We understand most parents will dismiss their child after the celebration. We want to make the process efficient for all. 
