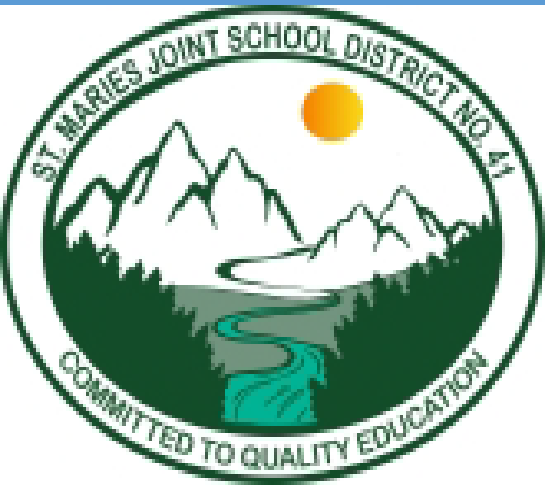
Action Steps

Goal 1 – Academic Achievement

- Incorporate social studies or science units in the elementary schools that align to the CTE classes (i.e. forestry)
- Teacher shares student results with students and students set academic goals with teacher

Goal 2 – College and Career Readiness

- Increase enrollment into CTE classes/programs

- Increase the “grade-level” rigor of the content

- Provide accurate and timely communication



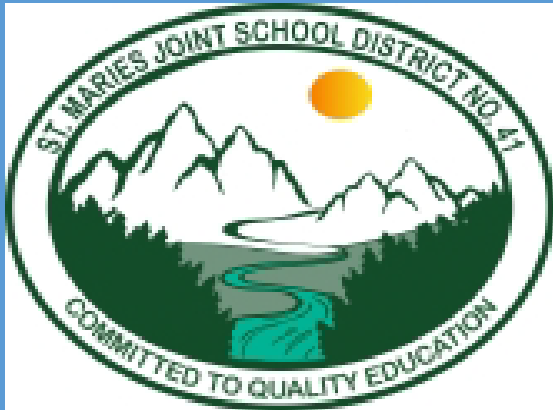


Mission and Vision
