- **Public Safety Career Exploration Camp** at Hennepin Technical College Brooklyn Park Campus. What are you doing with your summer? Are ready to explore a career as an Emergency Medical Technician, Firefighter, or Police Officer? Do you want to explore real equipment, tour local facilities, and meet professionals working in the field? In this three-week course, participants will learn what is required to work in each field, including education, certification, and skills. Students that complete and pass the assignments as a part of this camp will receive three college credits and will become nationally certified in CPR/ First Aid. Get Started Camp runs from June 10 - 27 and is held Monday-Thursday from 12:00 pm – 4:00 pm at the Brooklyn Park campus. The course is free to high school juniors and seniors. - **EP Online's Summer SOAR** offers flexible, asynchronous courses required for graduation, this program allows students to easily balance their studies with summer activities. EP Online teachers are on hand throughout the summer, providing continuous guidance and support as students work at their own pace. Students can earn up to two credits at \$200 per credit, and those eligible for free or reduced-price meal benefits can enroll for a refundable fee of \$100 upon successful completion of their courses.
