

SCHOOL BASED COUNSELING



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NEED FOR SCHOOL BASED COUNSELING

- After a 12 year partnership with CSG, they informed us this Spring that they would no longer be able to partner with us moving forward. The past two years, CSG found it increasingly difficult to hire staff to adequately meet our needs.
- We had over 50 learners using the services and could have had more if staffed in each of the buildings
- Reached out to two different agencies and none had availability to partner with us.
- Heard about Restore – reached out to owner and met with their team twice to see how they could support PVSD.
- They are able to commit to three counselors for 2024-2025 SY and a possibility of four if the need is there.

SCHOOL BASED COUNSELING WITH RESTORE COUNSELING

- No cost to the district. These supports run through insurance of families or private pay if family chooses.
- Steps that are taken to get a family connected:
 - Referral from family or school team
 - Restore staff contact family
 - Assigned a clinician
 - Intake with the family
- Quarterly meeting with school team
- Live google document to keep district staff updated on services and goals
- Will work with learners independently and work with family as needed for sessions
- Other resources they can offer – In-service for our staff, Summer therapy for learners, Touchstone Provider for families (\$50 to help with co-pay)
- They already partner with Ephrata SD and Linden Hall
