



High School Promotion/ Graduation Requirements

Students in grades nine through 12 will be awarded units of credit for courses that have been approved by the South Carolina Department of Education (SCDE).

Requirements for promotion to each grade level are as follows:

Promotion from 9th to 10th Grade:

A total of six (6) units of credit, including:

- English I, and
- 1 unit of mathematics;

Promotion from 10th to 11th Grade:

A total of twelve (12) units of credit, including:

- English I and II;
- two (2) units of mathematics;
- one (1) unit of Social Studies; and
- one (1) unit of science;

Promotion from 11th to 12th Grade:

A total of eighteen (18) units of credit, including:

- English I, II, and III;
- three (3) credits of mathematics;
- two (2) units of Social Studies and
- two (2) credits of science;

High School Graduation:

a total of twenty-four (24) total units of credit, including:

- English I, II, III, and IV;
- four units of mathematics;
- three units of science, including the Biology End-of-Course Exam;
- one unit of U.S. History which includes an End-of-Course Exam;
- ½ unit of Economics;
- ½ unit of Government;
- ½ unit of Personal Finance;
- one (1) additional unit of social studies;
- one (1) unit of physical education;
- one (1) unit of computer science; and
- one (1) unit foreign language or career and technology education.
