Project Overview:

 Purpose: The City of San Mateo has designated Delaware Street as a key north-south connector for bicycle access. The project aligns with the City's 2020 Bicycle Master Plan.

Goals:

- Improve safety for cyclists and pedestrians.
- Enhance connectivity to important community destinations.

• Provide a low-stress bicycle option for accessing district schools and surrounding areas.

Key Features:

- Implementation of Class IV physically separated bike lanes.
- Creation of a bicycle boulevard.
- Upgrading existing pedestrian facilities.
- Improved connections to existing and future bike facilities.

- **Sunday, July 7, 2024:** Same schedule as Saturday, with games starting at 2:00pm and 4:30pm, and doors opening at 1:00pm.
- **Wednesday, July 10, 2024:** The highlight of the event, featuring the Golden State Warriors vs. Sacramento Kings game, starting at 7:00pm. Doors open at 6:00pm.

The Summer League will include a total of 12 games, primarily showcasing rookies selected in the 2024 NBA Draft and players competing to secure spots on NBA and G League rosters.
