

Lenape High School
Course Selection for 2023-2024 – 9th grade

1. **FIRST: Enter demographic information for your child via the Incoming Student Enrollment link on the Lenape home page (lrhsd.org). [Click here for a shortcut.](#)**
2. All course requests will be made on-line using the Parent Genesis Request tab.
3. All course requests must be completed by the end of the day on Wednesday, December 21, 2022.
4. **Refer to the Lenape Regional High School District Program of Studies at www.lrhsd.org under Students/Parents tab.**
5. You must take 7 courses. An 8th course may be taken in place of study hall.
6. Health and Physical Education courses will be pre-populated. You do not need to select them.
7. Requirements in 9th grade: English, Math (Algebra I, Geometry or Algebra II), Biology, World Language, P.E.& Health 1, Visual/Performing Art or Career, Family Consumer Science/Vocational-Technical Ed.
8. **All students must list two second choice electives. Select your elective the same as you would your first choice and write ALTERNATE in the comment box.**
9. Changes may be done by a parent/guardian letter prior to **July 31, 2023**. Only errors will be adjusted in September.
10. Explanation of Levels:
 - HON: Honors – Requires a strong command of basic skills and is extremely rigorous. This is equivalent to the demands of a college level course.
 - ACC: Accelerated – Requires a good command of basic skills and the ability to perform in a rigorous program at a rapid pace. This is a college prep course.
 - CP: College Prep – Requires a command of basic skills and is moderately paced. This is a college prep course.
 - MOD: Modified – Reinforces and builds upon basic skills.
 - PR: Pullout Replacement – Special Education

11. Students must pass the equivalent of 15 credits first semester to be eligible for second semester sports. Students must pass 30 credits by the start of school year to be eligible for Fall and Winter sports in 10th grade.
12. All Honors and Accelerated courses count for NCAA eligibility. Most College Prep courses count for NCAA eligibility.
13. Check with your teachers and counselor for advice on courses and levels.

Any schedule change request must be submitted by the parent/guardian to the school Counseling Center prior to July 31, 2023.
