## Edmund G. Loges III

Athlete- Spring Track & Field, Winter Track, Cross Country, Soccer, Football Shawnee High School Class of 1992





Named the "1992 Shawnee High School Outstanding Male Athlete of the Year," Edmund G. Loges earned twelve varsity letters in multiple sports, which included four years Winter (Indoor) Track, four years Spring Track & Field, two years Cross Country, and one year each in both Soccer and Football. Ed was an accomplished Hurdler and Long Jumper in addition to running the 100 Dash, 200 Dash and 400 Meter Relay. He was the Winger in Soccer and both Receiver and Kickoff Returner for the Football Team.

In the 1991-1992 season, Ed was a key member of the first Shawnee Track & Field Team to win the first outdoor Group IV Sectional and State Titles. Ed was the **1992 Outdoor Group IV Track & Field State Champion**, placing 1st in the State Group IV 110M High Hurdles with a time of 14.34. His personal accomplishments that year also saw Ed as the **1992 New Jersey Winter Track All-Group State Champion** (Individual), placing 1<sup>st</sup> in the 55M High Hurdles.

Throughout this high school career, Ed's success saw him being named 1990 Burlington Country Liberty Division All Star, 1991 Burlington County Liberty Division All Star, 1992 Burlington County Liberty Division All Star, 1992 All Burlington County, 1992 All South Jersey, 1992 New Jersey Winter Track State Champion and 1992 Outdoor Group IV Track & Field State Champion. Ed set impressive school records in the 200M (21.9), Long Jump (23-6 ½), 110 High Hurdles (13.8), and the 4 X 110M HH Relay (62.2), all which still stand today.

Exceeding in the classroom as well as in Athletics, Ed graduated Shawnee with the distinction of being an Honor Roll student all four years.





Ed attended Bucknell University, majoring in Geology. While at Bucknell, Ed was on both the Bucknell Winter Track and Spring Track & Field teams throughout his collegiate career, playing for a cumulative total of four varsity years. His events included Long Jump, 110M High Hurdles, and 4 x 100. Ed reached the top spots of #3 on Bucknell University All Time Indoor top 10 (3<sup>rd</sup> in 55M High Hurdles at 7.58), #10 on Bucknell University All Time Indoor Top Ten, placing 8<sup>th</sup> in Long Jump at 23-4 4-3/4, and #5 on Bucknell University All Time Outdoor Top Ten, placing 5<sup>th</sup> in 110M High Hurdles at 14.4. Ed was All Patriot League Indoor in the 1993 and 1996 seasons and All Patriot League Outdoor in the 1996 season. Ed graduated Bucknell in 1996 and subsequently received his MBA at the University of Phoenix in 2005.

Ed currently lives in Chandler, Arizona with his wife Amy and children Ella Loges and Gracie Vincelette. Ed works in the field of Information Technology as an IT Services Manager for Insight.
