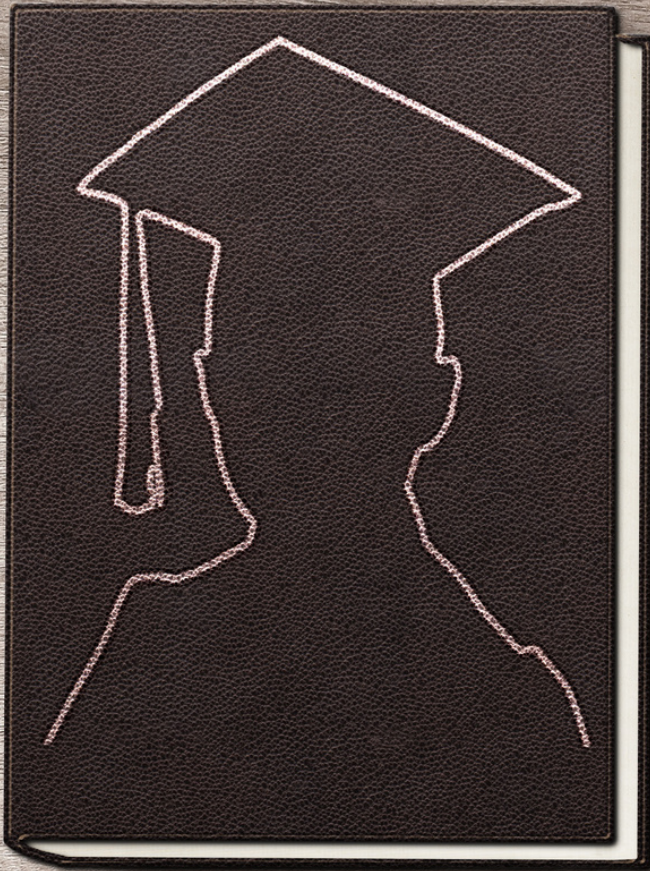

ADVANCED PLACEMENT AT KINGSWAY

Advanced Placement, or AP, refers to college level courses taught according to The College Board Advanced Placement Program and/or to courses designed to prepare students for College Board AP Tests. Success in AP courses can be an important factor in admission to colleges and universities.

AP courses receive appropriate weight in the Grade Point Average (GPA). Successful performance on AP tests, a score of 3 to 5, may lead to college credit and advanced placement in college. You can search at the link below to see if a particular college accepts AP credit:
