


Two Tracks: Four Courses are offered:

Applications are considered complete only if the following items are submitted. • Completed online application - provided through Introduction to Health Professions Schoology • 2 Teacher Recommendations (Health Professions and English/language arts preferred)		
January 29, 2024	Interview Sign Up, and Notification sent to student and parents/guardians: Emails will be sent home to students and parents/guardians verifying the student's chosen appointment slot for the interview.		
Feb 5th - 15th, 2024	Entrance Interviews begin: Students will complete the entrance interview with the School of Health Professions panel during the scheduled time slot. Students must come prepared and dressed professionally.		
March 10th, 2024	Official notification of acceptance or waitlist status will be generated, and students and parents/guardians will be notified.		
March 15th, 2024	Guidance will receive official acceptance for scheduling purposes.		
March 19, 2024	Freshman Information Session during SMART Lunch - L1 and L2 Google Form Sign Up sent home through Freshman Email and Schoology

What is considered for entry?

The admissions formula considers multiple measures including:

- Application of Interest
- Interview
 - Professionalism, what they know about the program. and level of interest in the field of healthcare
- Two Teacher recommendations
 - 1st- Science or English preferred
 - 2nd- Health Profession I Teacher
- Student Disciplinary Record is reviewed
- Student Attendance Record is reviewed and discussed.

Students who apply must have a minimum of a C (73 or higher) in IHP and passing their other core classes with good attendance and no disciplinary record.


