#### **EC Literacy Targeted Professional Development Plan**

Teachers will progress monitor students with classroom assessments and MAP data in order to implement guided reading groups. Teachers will conduct small guided reading groups daily with 120 minutes of dedicated ELA instruction. Phonics, spelling and word study, vocabulary, writing, fluency, and comprehension will be a part of the language arts block daily. Teachers will track student mastery of TEKS and have fluid grouping based on the data. Digital resources will support varying learning materials, at-home learning if necessary, data analysis of student growth, and increased student ownership of learning. Teachers will implement the curriculum with students, and administrators will monitor and support the teachers to ensure the best learning experiences for students.

PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT RECOMMENDED: Guided reading PD will be provided to the teachers in PLCs and follow-up coaching will be given to all teachers by our Instructional Coaches. Teachers will also continue to receive PD on data analysis and progress monitoring. All PreK through 3rd grade teachers will complete The Science of Reading Academies over the next three years. All HS and PK teaching staff will complete the eCIRCLE Professional Development Series with a focus on Letter Knowledge, Written Expression and Small Group Instruction. Professional learning opportunities will be both online and in person and based on progress monitoring data that is collected and analyzed three times per year.
