

SUPPLEMENTAL MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

SUPPLEMENTAL MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN THE SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS AND BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE CHAPPAQUA CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT, hereinafter referred to as “the District” and **CHAPPAQUA CONGRESS OF TEACHERS**, hereinafter referred to as the “CCT”;

WHEREBY, the District and the CCT believe it to be in their mutual best interests to offer an untenured teacher certain rights pursuant to Article 37 of the current CCT collective bargaining agreement

NOW, THEREFORE, it is agreed as follows:

Bargaining unit member #6545 who does not reside within the school district, shall be allowed to enroll their child in Horace Greeley High School as an tenth grade student during the 2024-25 school year under the following terms and conditions:

Upon enrollment, the employee and their child will be subject to all the rights, privileges, obligations, and expectations as set forth in Article 37.

If the probationary teacher resigns from employment on or before June 30, 2026 on their own accord they shall be required to pay the District the Non-Resident Tuition rate applicable to the attendance of their child at HGHS during the 2024-2025 academic year.

This supplemental memorandum of agreement shall be non-precedent setting, and not be introduced by either party in any future proceedings {negotiations, administrative, or judicial}.

SO AGREED this 28th day of May, 2024, subject to ratification by the Board of Education.
