Passport Health/Staying Healthy Medical Services will be conducting a vaccination clinic to get your students up to date for the school year.

A printed current vaccine record or note from school stating missing vaccines is required.

(Electronic proof cannot be accepted. A paper copy must be provided.)

- Parent or guardian must be present.
- Only students attending the school district that is hosting the clinic, age 3-18, can be seen. This should not replace any well child checkups at the pediatrician.
- If you have older children who resist shots or children with special needs, please refer to your pediatrician.

This clinic is being offered as a community service event and should not replace a visit to your pediatrician. Staff and supplies are limited so the clinic may be discontinued if supplies or time runs out. We cannot guarantee that everyone will be seen.
