RE: Bruin Boys Head Track and Field Resignation

Fargo South High School announces **Mr. Cameron Dockter** is stepping down as head boys' track and field coach for the Bruins, a position he has held since 2019 and from 2011 to 2017.

Mr. Dockter finished the 2024 season as the East Region and the North Dakota Boys Track and Field Coach of the Year. The Bruins 4 X 200 Relay team of Jaylen Runnels, A.J. Moore, Justin Zulu, and Austin Zulu set a state record while winning the event at the State meet this year. The Bruins also had the state champion 4 X 400 Relay team and finished in fifth place at the State meet after finishing in second place at the East Region meet. **Mr. Dockter** was also the 2015 East Region and North Dakota Boys Track and Field Coach of the Year.

Mr. Dockter was an assistant football coach and assistant track and field coach at South High for more than 20 years. He has been a teacher in the Fargo Public Schools for more than 20 years and has retired from teaching as well.

Fargo South High School Activities Coordinator Mike Beaton states "**Mr. Dockter** created positive relationships with his athletes by going above and beyond to help them both as athletes and as people. The impact he had on the lives of students and athletes in his career as a teacher and a coach of football and track and field is immeasurable. I thank him for all he has done for our students and South High."

The search for Mr. Dockter's replacement will begin immediately.
