#### Attendance

Students who are chronically absent—meaning they **miss at least 15 days of school in a year**—are at serious risk of falling behind in school.

For example, if we have been in school for 30 days and if your scholar has 3 or more absences they are considered chronically absent and could potentially be retain.

#### **Grading Policy**

Grades for all students\* will be calculated based on the following scale:

Quiz/Formative Unit Tests (40%) Classwork/Projects (25%) Homework (20%) Journals/Notebooks (15%)

#### Cell Phones

Students are <u>NOT</u> to have the following in their possession while in school: cell phones, iPod, Walkman's, electronic games, etc. Unless the teacher has required it for an activity.

All students upon entering the building are required to turn their cell phones off and store their cell phones in their assigned cell phone locker until the end of the day.
