GUIDELINES FOR SAFE SCHOOL BUS RIDING



Arrive at bus stop 5 minutes early.

- Do not leave!
- Respect property and other students





Bus pass required for every student, every ride.

- Passes are free (If lost, there maybe replacement fee)
- Pick up passes at registered school
- Questions? Call (720) 972-4300

Getting on the bus:

Watch for traffic.

- Look before crossing the street
- Always cross in front of bus (not the back), being visible to driver at all times

Wait for bus in safe place!

- Stand 5 giant steps away from the curb
- Never play near or in the road

Wait for bus to stop and driver to open the door before loading.

Once given the all clear by driver:



- Get on immediately
- SCAN BUS PASS
- Stand in a single-file line without, crowding, pushing or shoving

Seats are assigned for all elementary and middle school students.



- Stay seated, facing forward and with your back against the back seat cushion
- Remain in your seat while bus is in motion

Seats can be assigned for high school students if necessary.

While on the bus:

Listen to your bus driver!

- Follow all instructions
- Obey all rules and be cooperative



Complete silence at railroad crossings.



Headphones required

for all audio devices, cell phones and tablets.

Keep aisles clear.

 Keep body parts and items (backpacks, lunch bags, instruments, coats, etc) in your seat

Keep body parts inside the bus at all times.

- Serious injury could result from being struck by an object outside the bus
- No pushing, shoving, grabbing, fighting, throwing objects, etc.

Exit bus properly.

- Wait for bus to stop
- Only exit through front door, unless driver instructs otherwise

The following are NOT allowed on the bus:*

- Abusive, profane or obscene language
- Shouting or loud noises
- Fighting
- Bullying (physical/verbal)
- Threats to people/school/bus
- Taking pictures or video recording
- Tobacco, drugs or alcohol (possession or use)
- Weapons
- Lighters, fire starters
- Laser pointers
- Animals (living or otherwise)
- Glass containers
- Balloons
- Scooters
- Long boards
- Hover boards
- Skateboards
- Oversized instruments
- *District policies are enforced at all times

All violations of these rules are dealt with on an individual basis using the

Transportation Student Management and Discipline Guidelines.

All buses record activity during every bus ride.
