OTHER ACTIVITIES

DRAMA (Grades 6-8)
This is open for any student who likes to perform or help behind the scenes. Fall and winter performances. \$75 fee

FTC ROBOTICS (Grades 6-8) Robotics students in grades 6-8 will learn to think like engineers. Teams design, build, and code robots to compete in an alliance format against other teams. 16981 Gear Ratios will compete in the Vermilion League in 4 separate competitions. \$75 fee

JAZZ BAND (Grades 6-8)
Jazz is open to all Discovery music students. Rehearsals will be held twice a week from October to April. \$75 fee

KNOWLEDGE BOWL (Grades 6-8)
Team competition covering many subjects. Five member teams are made up of individuals with strengths covering as many areas as possible. Season runs from Oct. to Dec. \$75 fee

MARCHING BAND (Grades 8-12)
Rehearsals begin in mid May for the Alexandria Marching Band. \$200 fee

STORMY STRINGS
This orchestra is open to all grade levels by audition. \$75 fee
