2024-2025 Standardized Attire / Cell Phone Policy

Shirts or Blouses:

- Long or short sleeves with collar * Must be tucked into pants or skirts
- Sagging, baggy, tagged or gang-affiliated attire is not permitted
- No tank tops are allowed * **University shirt is permitted only on Thursdays**
- **Garcia M.S. spirit shirt is permitted only on Fridays**

PANTS

- ✓ Solid in khaki or dark blue / black jeans
- ✓ No faded blue/black jeans, jeggings, leggings or spandex allowed
- ✓ Girls may wear skirts, shorts (up to knees), or Capri pants in khaki or blue jeans
- ✓ Boys may wear khaki or blue jean shorts (up to knees); Worn at the waist ; No baggy pants; Hemmed at an appropriate length; No frayed or cut cuffs
- ✓ Belts are permissible, not woven, nor with initials, nor hanging down



Sweaters / Jackets: with zipper or button down – **No hoodies**

Shoes:

- ✓ Tennis shoes and closed shoes are **ONLY** permitted
- ✓ **No** crocs or imitation crocs
- ✓ **No** flip flops sandals or slippers

The following are permissible for boys:	The following are permissible for girls:
<p>Shirts: Collared shirts, polo style shirts (shirt tails tucked in)</p> <p>Pants: blue & black jeans (no faded jeans), Khaki (no other color) that fit on the waste; hemmed at an appropriate length</p> <p>Shorts: up to knees</p> <p>Shoes: tennis shoes, closed shoes</p>	<p>Shirts: Collared shirts, polo style shirts (shirt tails tucked in)</p> <p>Pants: blue & black jeans (no faded jeans), Khaki (no other color) that fit on the waist; hemmed at an appropriate length; may wear capris (blue jeans or khaki)</p> <p>Shorts/Dresses/Skirts: up to knees</p> <p>Shoes: tennis shoes, closed shoes</p> <p>Piercings: ONLY on <u>ears</u> (should not be overly exaggerated)</p>
The following are PROHIBITED for boys:	The following are PROHIBITED for girls:
<p>Shirts: Muscle shirts or sleeveless t-shirts; shirts that contain pictures that promote gangs, alcohol, etc.,</p> <p>Pants: no baggy, rolled up from the bottom</p> <p>Shorts: more than 2" above the knee cap</p> <p>Shoes: flip-flop sandals, slippers, crocs</p> <p>Piercings: on any part of the body including ears and face- eyebrows, nose, tongue, lips, etc.</p> <p>Hair: Distracting hairstyles; hair color other than natural color; any kind of FADING (due to misconception of gang affiliation)</p> <p>Eyebrow Slits- NOT allowed</p> <p>Hickes: should be covered at home with a Band-Aid/gauze, etc.</p>	<p>Shirts: Muscle shirts or sleeveless t-shirts; shirts that contain pictures that promote gangs, alcohol, etc., Clothing that is strapless, having spaghetti straps, bare midriff, cut-out backs, or having provocative/low necklines</p> <p>Pants: no baggy or too tight, rolled up from bottom; no leggings/tights (including spandex)</p> <p>Shorts/dresses/skirts: more than 2" above the knee cap</p> <p>Shoes: open-toe shoes, flip-flop sandals, crocs</p> <p>Piercings: on any part of the body or face- eyebrows, nose, tongue, lips, etc. Earring are allowed at a reasonable size</p> <p>Hair: Distracting hairstyles; hair color other than natural color; any kind of FADING (due to misconception of gang affiliation)</p> <p>Eyebrow Slits- NOT allowed</p> <p>Hickes: should be covered at home with a Band-Aid/gauze, etc.</p>

Cell phone/Electronic Device – school policy

If students are caught using their cell phones/electronic device anywhere on campus, the following will take place:

1st time- A Verbal Warning: device will be confiscated and returned to student at the end of the day.

2nd time- A discipline referral will be issued, device will be confiscated and returned ONLY to guardian(s).

3rd time- A discipline referral will be issued, device will be confiscated and will be returned during after a Parent Conference with campus principal.

NOTE: Additional cell phone confiscations may result in student not being permitted to bring the device to school.
