Dear Parents and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER) which provides key information on the 2018-19 educational progress Douglas R. Welch High School. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. If you have any questions about the AER, please contact Jennifer Burns for assistance.

For the 2018-19 school year, schools were identified using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that has at least one underperforming student subgroup. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that has three or more underperforming student subgroups. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance is in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or has a graduation rate at or below 67%. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

\* Note TSI and ATS definitions were changed for the 2018-19 school year per federal requirements. The new definitions are:

TSI - The school has at least one subgroup performing in the bottom 25% within each applicable accountability index component.

ATS - The school has met the criteria for TSI identification and has at least one subgroup performing at the same level as a CSI school.

Our school has not been given one of these labels.

Students that have been selected to attend Douglas R. Welch High School qualify for the program based on credits earned at a traditional high school. Credit deficient students make up our population of learners. 30% of all students are considered homeless, many of which are doubled up. 20% of our students are school of choice enrollments. Our school provides free lunch and breakfast to all students.



When analyzing local and state assessment data it is clear to see that many of our students have gaps in their understandings. We see this in all four subject areas. The most inconsistent areas for students are English Language Arts and mathematics. Staff meet during professional learning communities to determine individual student needs. Over the next two years we will be installing an Early Warning System to assist in the identification of students needing intervention. This work will also continue at Ionia High School in an attempt to support students early in 9th grade.

Students are selected to attend Douglas R. Welch High School by the number of credits earned. At the end of each semester teams of educators review student credits, attendance, and behavior. Students then are selected for transfer to Douglas R. Welch based on the data reviewed.

Services and programs that are used to support these students are found in our school improvement plan. This plan includes content specific training for teachers, professional learning communities, and continued implementation supports for our district-wide multi-tiered system of supports.

Core curriculum at Douglas R. Welch has been selected to support all learners. Currently we utilize the following programs to meet the requirements of the Michigan Merit Curriculum:

Partnering with parents and guardians is very important to the work we do with families. Phone, email, mail and text messaging is utilized to keep parents informed. We do continue to host parent teacher conferences. In the fall we had 23/56 (41 %) of parents in attendance. In the spring we had 13/58 (22%) of parents in attendance.

We did not have any students enrolled in dual enrollment, AP/IB or receiving credit for those classes.

Overall we are excited for the determination our students have. Each student that attends Welch has a unique plan created for graduation. This often includes students participating in a career technology education at Heartlands. Our students and staff work hard together to support our students toward their goals of graduation, college and/or careers.
