

BISHOP HAWAWEENEY'S CASE IS POSTPONED.

Bishop Raphael Hawaweeney, of the Syrian Church, lately known to fame in Brooklyn because of his war with the editor of a Syrian newspaper, appeared in the Butler street court this morning in answer to the charges made against him resultant from the riot a week ago, in which it was alleged the Bishop attempted to shoot a policeman and shot one of the editor's followers in the leg. Ex-District Attorney Osborne represented the Bishop and asked for an adjournment, which was granted. Consul-General of Russia Nicola Ladiginsky was present in court to watch the proceedings.
