RUSSIAN CONSUL IN COURT.

Accompanied Bishop Hawaweeny, Who Is Charged With Trying to Shoot Cop.

Accompanied by the Russian Consul General to New York City, Nicola De Ladidensky, and twenty of his followers, Bishop Raphael Hawaweeny this morning went to the Butler Street Police Court, where he was arraigned on a charge of having attempted to shoot Policeman Mullen, of the Butler Street Station. The gathering of Russians, several of whom were full dress official costumes, attracted much attention.

Bishop Hawaweeny, who is the head of the Greek Russian Church in North America, is charged with having caused disturbances among the members of his church, and in a riot which resulted, of having threatened to shoot the policeman at the corner of Pacific and Clinton streets, on Monday night, September 18. Magistrate Steers adjourned the hearing until October 11.
