

Draft A complies with the basic districting criteria and incorporates the following direction, public input and Communities of Interest (COI):

- A west Hayward COI was kept intact in District A
- District B was made by combining the elementary school attendance areas and using feeder patterns of the Longwood, Burbank, and Park elementary schools.
- A submitted Glassbrook/Tyrell/Tennyson COI was the basis of District C but had to be split to comply with the equal population requirement.
- District D combines the unincorporated areas of Cherryland, Castro Valley, and Fairview in a single district and maintains the Cherryland elementary school feeder pattern.
- An east Hayward COI was kept whole in District E
