Incoming 7th Grade

Summer 2024

Participate in the Summer Reading Challenge by reading 20-30 minutes per day and tracking that time on the [St. Anne Summer Reading Challenge Log](#). Students who read 1,000 minutes this summer will be eligible for a free dress pass in the fall!

In addition, incoming 7th-grade students are expected to read two books from the list attached and complete two reading projects (for each book). All questions regarding book approval or projects should be asked prior to summer break. Reading Project One: From the attached list, choose a fiction book to read. After reading the book, follow the directions on slides 2-3 to complete your project.

Reading Project Two: Choose a second book from the attached list (fiction or non-fiction) and create a book review flier following the directions on slides 5-7.

Be prepared to submit your assignments to your English teacher during the first week of school. Assignments created electronically may be submitted electronically. Assignments made by hand should be brought to your teacher. Directions for submitting the assignments will be given the first week of school.
