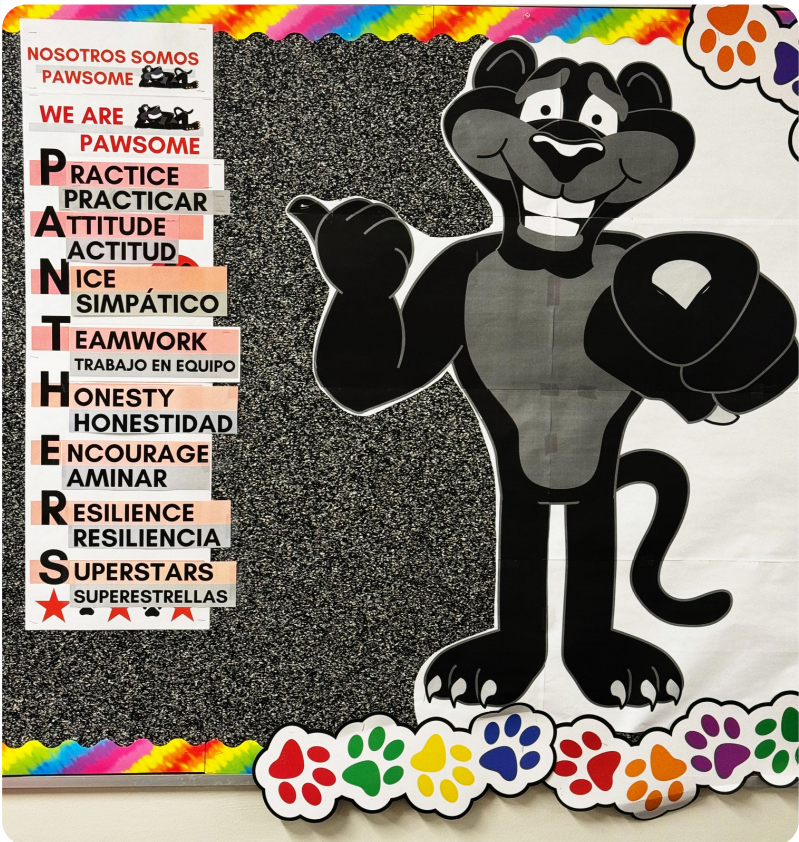


PVE students are SUPERSTARS!
