ART

CODING



In coding, students will continue to develop their 21st-century skills of problem-solving, critical thinking, communication, collaboration, creativity, and innovation. Each class will have a chance to work with grade-level appropriate hardware like Microbits, Meowbits, and Makey Makeys as well as robots like Beebots, Ozobots, Dash and Dot, Spheros, Indi Race Cars, and Codepillars. We will also integrate language arts, math, science, and social studies with computer science to create projects in coding programs like Scratch and Scratch Jr. It will be so amazing to see their creativity, knowledge, and excitement come to life through coding.

DANCE

In dance, movement is integrated with language arts, science, math, and social studies in order to offer students a full, kinesthetic learning experience.
