CLASSIFICATION SCHEDULE

District

School district use holds priority over all community use and meets the following criteria.

- 1. Use is coordinated, directed, managed, and staffed by district employees who are compensated for the specific activity through the district.
- 2. Use is covered by the district's self-insurance policy.
- 3. School District activities include:
 - a. The daily educational schedule
 - b. SKPS's Oregon School Activities Association (OSAA) sport, activity practices and competitions. (https://www.osaa.org/)
 - c. SKPS sponsored middle school athletics.
 - i. Volleyball/Football/Cross-Country
 - ii. Basketball/Wrestling
 - iii. Soccer/Track
 - d. Elementary and middle-school after-school programs
 - e. School theater, arts, and music performances
 - f. Parent Advisory Clubs
 - g. Advisory committees appointed by the School Board
 - h. Staff Wellness Activities
 - i. Subject to policy HUM-A021, Duties of Employees.
 - ii. The wellness activity and the use of the facility or area are not open to the public but for District staff only.
 - iii. If an outside contractor is hired to provide a service at a District site, the contractor will pay the usual facility use fee or will reduce by a like amount the customary charge to benefit the staff. The Chief Operations Officer or designee must approve the fee being charged.

Booster, PTA, Alumni

- 1. Booster, PTA and Alumni events are not covered by district insurance and must have own liability insurance policy.
- 2. Booster, PTA and Alumni events recognized as "District" events for the following uses (only):
 - a. Meetings
 - b. Ceremonies
 - c. Fundraisers 100% proceeds must go to SKPS account to qualify as "School District Use".

Tier I

Nonprofit organizations for the purposes of conducting youth activities and services for school-aged children and civic groups:

- 1. Youth sports (examples: Little League, Mat Clubs)
- 2. High school sports clubs
- 3. Scouting, 4H Clubs, etc.
- 4. Community theater, arts, and music
- 5. District Association Meetings (SKEA, ASK-ESP, OEA)
- 6. City, county, state, and federal agencies
- 7. Colleges and universities
- 8. Non-SKPS school districts
- 9. Neighborhood associations
- 10. OSAA competitions non-SKPS teams
- 11. Youth serving events and/or fundraisers where less than 100% of profits or proceeds are designated to a SKPS account.
- 12. Summer Youth Camps that charge participants:
 - a. The following rules will apply to summer activities that collect a fee to participate (i.e., sports camps, music programs, drama).
 - i. No salary will be paid for staff or student helpers.
 - ii. Participant fees may be charged for actual expenses.
 - iii. Any money collected beyond actual costs will revert to the Associated Student Body Funds and may be earmarked for a particular sport or club, such as basketball or band.
 - iv. The school bookkeeper will keep all records, which will be subject to district audit of all revenues and expenses.
 - v. The regular application and contract forms will be completed.

Tier II

Other nonprofit organizations and activities, including but not limited to:

- 1. Private school use.
- 2. Services for adults, or mixed audiences of adults and youth.
- 3. Faith community activities such as church services and ministry groups.
- 4. Baccalaureate services must be under the full sponsorship of a private organization(s) which will assume total responsibility for financial support including rental and personnel costs incurred in the use of the facility.
 - a. The District will assume no direct or indirect financial support for baccalaureate services.
 - b. The date, time and place of a baccalaureate service are information that is to be distinctly separate from graduation information and not provided through District publications.
 - c. Attendance at a baccalaureate service will be strictly voluntary.
 - d. District staff will not take part in the planning of a baccalaureate service during the school day.
 - e. District staff will exercise caution in participation in baccalaureate services so that the District will not be perceived as sponsoring the service.

Tier III

Commercial use and for-profit events and activities:

- 1. Ticketed events.
- 2. Organizations without tax-exempt status.
- 3. Political organizations and campaigns.

Excluded Use

The District will not extend use or rent facilities to the following:

- 1. Individuals, private parties, or private groups not listed or active on the Oregon Business Registry.
- 2. Organizations or groups whose policies advocate overthrow of the government of the United States of America (or any of its political subdivisions).
- 3. Organizations or groups that promote illegal, racist, or discriminatory practices.
- 4. Overnight stays by non-district or community groups are strictly prohibited.
- 5. Racing or Obstacle Course events involving motor vehicles of any kind.
