The SHAC meeting was called to order at 1:37 by Abigail Trevino. She welcomed all in attendance and discussed the agenda for the SHAC meeting. Reviewed agenda items for today's meeting.

The meeting minutes from February 6, 2024 were reviewed and approved.

**Roles and Responsibilities of SHAC:** Mission-Vision- Goals, review the roles and responsibilities in slides.

## Health Services:

Senate Bill 294- Medications for respiratory distress (Candi Howard) highlights the importance of administering respiratory distress medication because it has the ability to save students' lives. If policy is adopted, each school must require 2 personnel and/or school volunteers and trained to administer medication for respiratory distress present during regular school hours.

Asthma 411- (Leslie Allsop) Safe and care texas - Asthma 411 provides resources for school nurses to help children who have trouble breathing. As part of the program, a

school nurse can give a breathing treatment to a child who is struggling to breathe while at school. Also provides learning tools for schools and families. These learning tools help children and families understand asthma better. When families understand asthma better, they can help their child feel more in control of breathing and improve asthma symptoms. Program goals are less calls to the EMS at school, improve school attendance and help the kids with asthma breathe better and learn better.

### **Counseling, Psychological & Social Services:**

CASA Johnson County- children foster fiscal sexual abuse and/or work with police isd Johnson county, prevention to help kids with any abuse. Video was played to show what the program is based on.

Free service 2 instructional periods and will get with kids one to one so they can understand better and topics will be sent home. They will fill a form out and it will also help them know if the kids have been abused, it will always go through the district before they take any decision. JH and HS is required to be taking 2 a year, there will be transparency in all subjects with parents and educators before the program is presented with students. Elementary general safety k-12.

- Reach - Nikki -Reach is putting together youth summer socials. Alley cats will be a sponsor. Members will have meetings. The students will benefit by being able to use this experience on their college application form.

### **Nutritional Services:**

Local Wellness Plan Assessment, results of the local wellness plan assessment will be published on the district website and presented to SHAC during the September meeting.

**Triennial assessment** was presented by Abigail Trevino explained that she emailed every campus and if they would like to make changes to our district goals, any of the SHAC members are welcomed to send her an email to discuss.

**Wellness plan:** Abigail goes over the district wellness plan goal by goal and asks for evidence from SHAC members. There are members who wish to share evidence in more detail. They will update the document on the google drive with detailed information in the evidence column.

### **Parent/Community Involvement:**

SHAC Family Night-Lori Nunez: partner with someone that attended and talk about the good and bad experiences of SHAC night.

Back to school bash: August 1 (tentatively) , new spot for REACH because they are usually in a high traffic area and it's hard to manage the crowds. Trevino suggests we

put them in the cafeteria near the nutrition tables to give families something to do while parents fill out free/reduced lunch applications.
