When you register for the reading challenge, you can then pick up a sign up bag with prizes in it and start earning raffle tickets towards the grand prizes at the end of the summer. Your raffle tickets will be entered into a drawing if you complete your age group challenge: 0-3 yrs. = 10 hours, 4-6 yrs. = 10 hours, 7-11 yrs. = 15 hours, 12-17 yrs. = 20 hours, and 18+ = 30 hours. You can also earn raffle tickets for each program you attend at the library during the Summer Reading Challenge event (June 8- August 16). The raffle takes place on August 17 at the Wrap-Up Party. If you complete the challenge for your age group, you also earn a completion bag with prizes in it. The sign up and completion bags also come with your choice of a free book to keep.
