

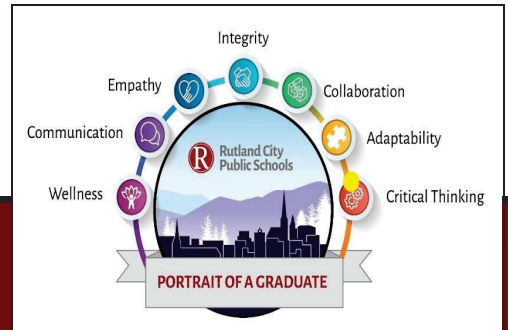

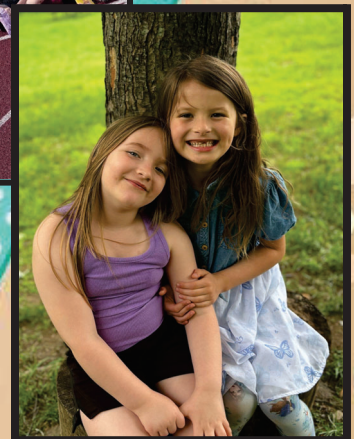
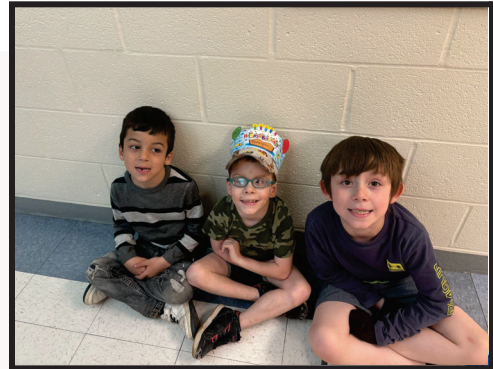

NW students had so much learning about traditional west african drum culture through an interactive experience with drumming & dancing! So cool!

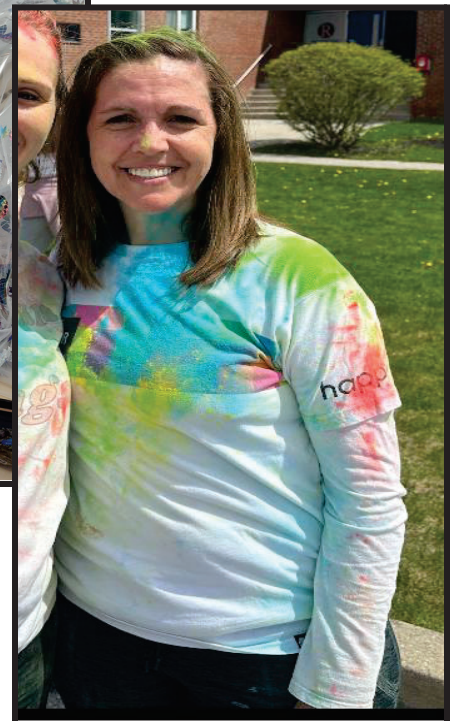


A note from our Counselors

MAY'S STAR STUDENTS

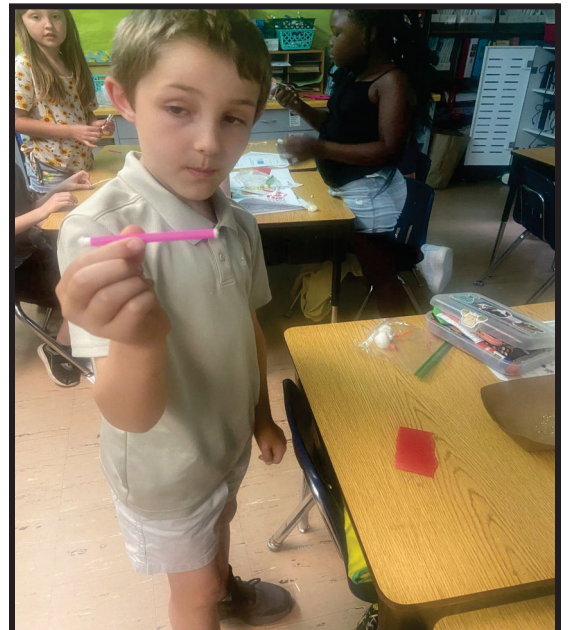
