

Site Evaluation



Tax Implications ___

High School Building Project

•	Project Cost	Mills	Tax – Annual	<u> Tax – Monthly</u>
•	\$70 million	1.395	\$99	\$8
•	\$90 million	1.936	\$138	\$12
•	\$100 million	2.207	\$157	\$13
•	\$110 million	2.477	\$177	\$15
•	\$120 million	2.748	\$196	\$16
•	\$145 million	3.425	\$244	\$20

• Estimates based upon assumptions 4/2013.

Tax Implications - Assumptions

- Include High School Building Project only
- Added to existing school property taxes for duration of bonds funding the project
- Assume 30-year bonds
- Includes ½ (one half) mill of existing capital reserve budget to fund project
- Based on average assessed value of a single family residential property in SCASD (\$71,296)
- Assessed value equals 50% of 1995 market value

Tax Implications – Other Factors

- Term of bonds 10, 15, 20, 25 years
 - (assumed 30 years)
- Change funding from capital reserve budget from ½ mill
- Interest rates
- Issuance of bonds during construction period
- Private donations
- PlanCon reimbursement

Survey Goals


