The construction technician program is an introduction to safety practices, tools and equipment, trade-related math, blueprint reading, and job opportunities in the construction industry. Students will be able to perform all coursework related to handling, placing, and finishing concrete. Basic wood framing, concrete form building, roofing applications, thermal and moisture protection, exterior finishing, CNC design and operation, safety practices, general construction tools, and equipment uses/operations. Basic introduction will be covered in the following trade areas, residential electrical services, safety, drain waste and vent systems, plastic pipe and fittings, copper pipe and fittings. Students will receive hands-on experience building on-site portable buildings and various community service projects as well as general maintenance projects on campus.
