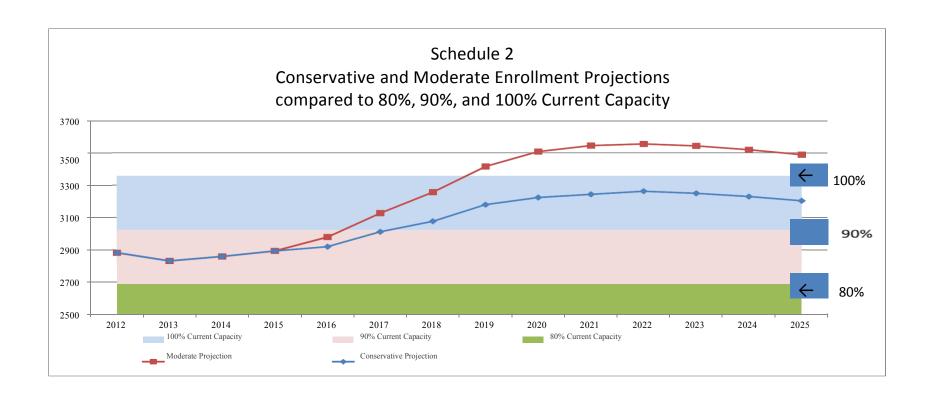

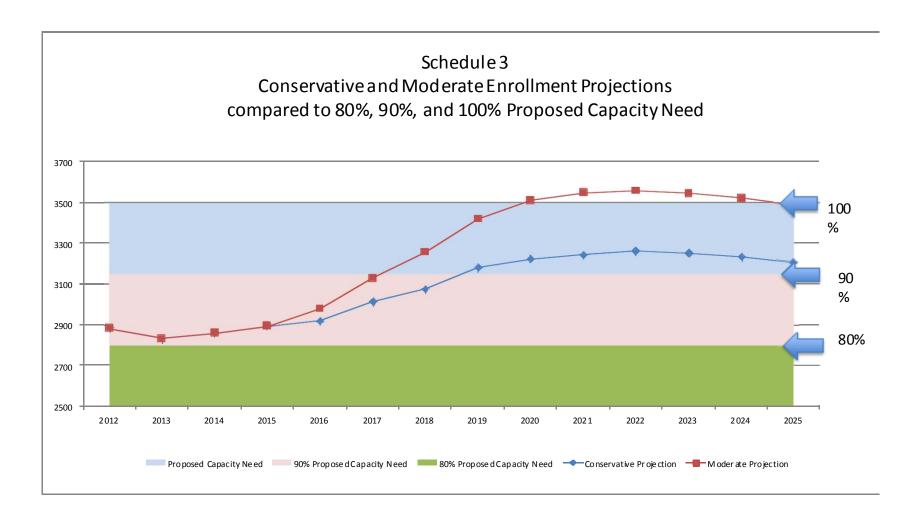

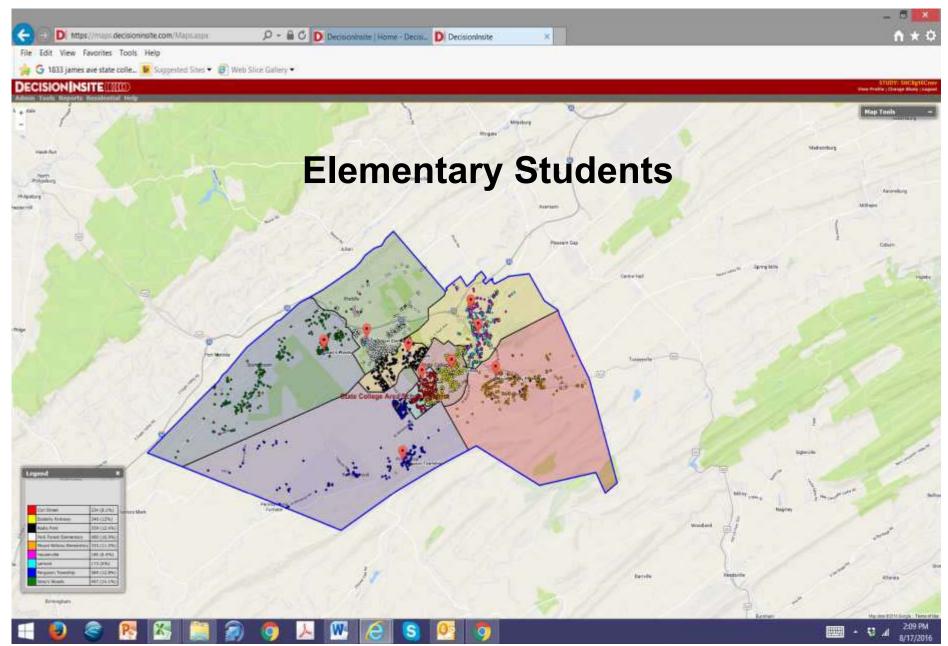

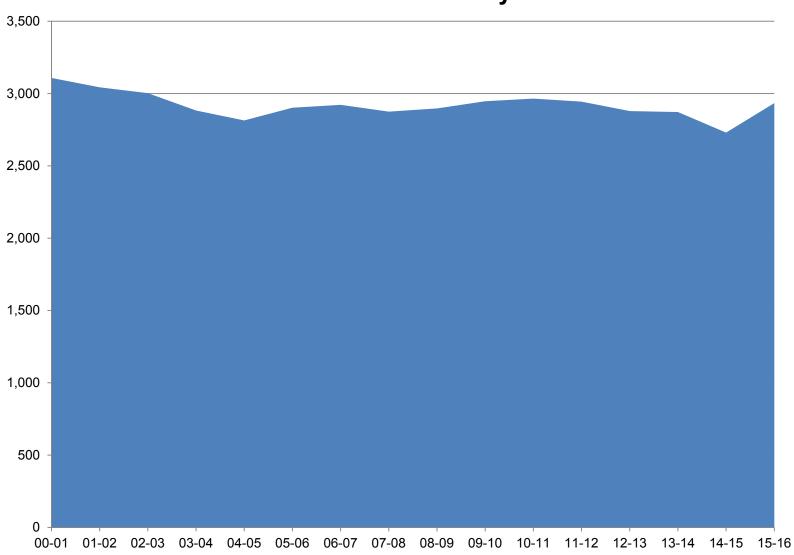


State College Area School District Elementary School Locations and Attendance Areas
