Budget Hearing Final Budget Approval

- To reiterate our budget proposal has assumed that Penn State would return to inperson classes – which was announced yesterday
 - Therefore, no further changes necessary in our budget development at this point.

6/15/2020 \$158,442,690

3/2/2020 \$168,500,530

Difference \$ 10,057,840

- Increase of \$561,365
 - Safety and Security Grants
 - Includes a broader scope than previous years for COVID expenses

Differences related:

- Removal of 2% tax increase
- Lower assessed value growth
- Lower real estate tax collection
- Lower earned income tax
- Lower realty transfer tax
- Lower delinquent real estate tax revenue
- Lower tuition revenue
- Lower interest on investments
- Lower retirement and social security reimbursement

Reductions in Expenses

- Salaries
- Benefits
- Services
- Supplies
- Capital expenses
 - Reserve transfer and deferred maintenance expense

Fund Balance

- Balanced budget
 - Does not include transfer to capital reserve
 - Decrease in deferred maintenance capital expenditures

Real Estate Tax Bills

Pending legislation

- HB 2460 and SB 1125
- May change requirements on real estate tax bills

Debt Refunding

- Preliminary refunding analysis
 for Series A & B 2014
 - Estimated savings of 8%
 - Generally require 3%
 - August September 2020 timeframe
