IB Course Fees

Student/Family Responsibility:

Course fee/per course - \$119

Cost to Families: \$119 x 6 courses

Total Diploma Programme Cost: \$714

Cost to Families: \$119 x 2 courses

Total Career-related Programme Cost: \$238

Rationale: Consistent with and comparable to other SCASD opportunities, e.g. students taking AP courses pay the exam fee.

*No student will be denied access because of an inability to pay.
