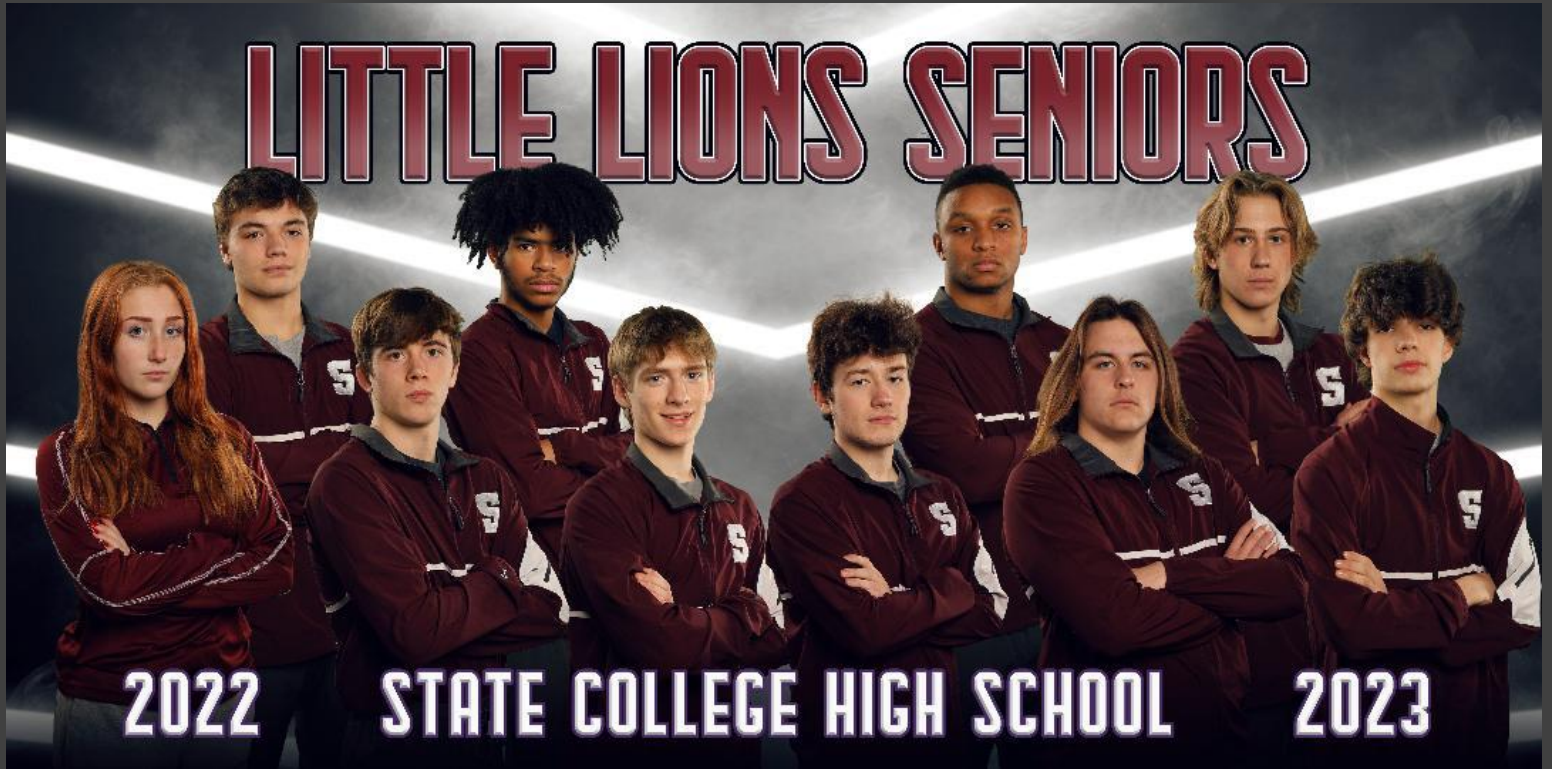

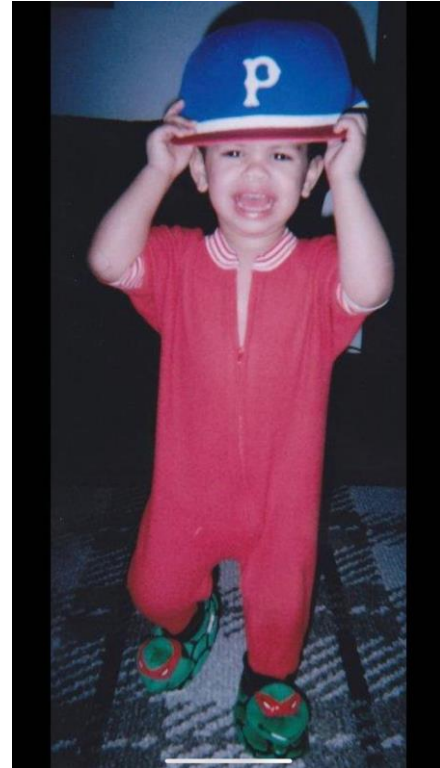
What is your favorite high school wrestling memory?
